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Schedule of program sessions and activities

The Communities of Giving Legacy Initiative requires that parents/guardians and students agree to make a commitment to participate and complete the Capstone component of this program. Students selected to participate in The Young Philanthropists experience must commit to attend all meetings and fully participate in sessions.

Meetings will revolve around the following activities:

- **January 19, 2021:** Application deadline
- **January 25, 2021:** Student Interviewing and selection
- **January 27, 2021:** Student/Parent Orientation Session
- **February 9, 2021:** Session 1 – Common language and broad understanding of the charitable sector. Definition of Philanthropy.
- **February 23, 2021:** Session 2 – Business of Philanthropy including charitable fund management. Definition and purpose of an endowment fund.
- **March 9, 2021:** Session 3 – How Nonprofit organizations work, how they are funded and the importance of seeking grants.
- **March 23, 2021:** Session 4 – Virtual Site Visits, use of a guided interview worksheet and a proposal rating instrument.
- **April 6, 2021:** Session 5 – Learn consensus building techniques with simulated consensus building exercises.
- **April 20, 2021:** Session 6 – Ranking and rating data compiled. Review of the concept of conflict-of-interest disclosure.
- **May 11, 2021:** Session 7 – Concept and practice of social enterprise. Design a social enterprise project.
- **May 25, 2021:** Session 8 – Test and evaluate youth experience and prepare for the end of year Capstone Ceremony.
